



## **ELDON ROESLER SCHOLARSHIP**

The Wisconsin Agri-Service Association (WASA) is proud to administer the Eldon Roesler Scholarship. Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded according to the following criteria:

1. Must be a Wisconsin resident,
2. Have completed (or will complete by May) a minimum of one year of study at a Wisconsin University, college, or Vocational Technical College in an agricultural discipline or in another discipline with the stated intent of pursuing a career in an agriculture-related field,
3. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, and
4. Demonstrate (in written form) qualities of leadership, academic ability, and financial need.

The Scholarship Committee will select the best qualified recipients. As a final criterion between equally qualified candidates, preference will be given to children of WASA members, associates, and to children of employees of WASA companies.

The award will be paid in two installments, \$500.00 in August and \$500 in December, to each recipient. If the recipient drops out of school, the second installment of the award will not be paid.
